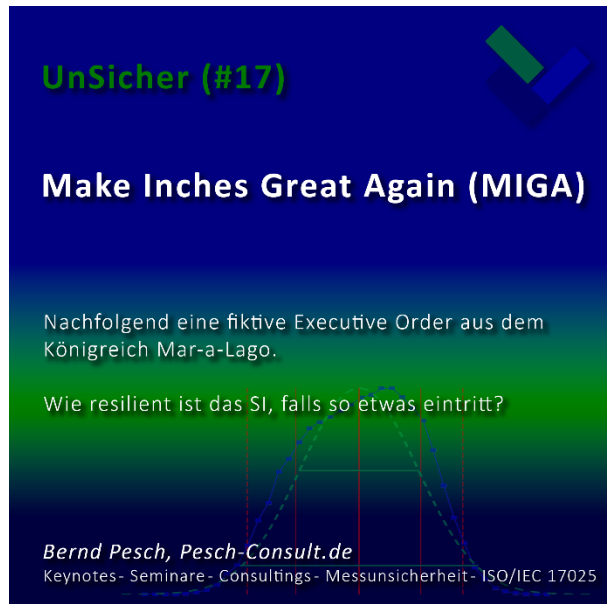




17 Make Inches Great Again
